- Light Jacket or Sweatshirt (Depends on Temperature)
- Undershorts
- Socks
- Boots or Sneakers

## **Clothing and Bedding**

- All items packed in a soft-sided duffel bag or backpack
- Sweater or Jacket It will be a bit cold overnight
- Additional T-shirt
- Additional Shorts (or long pants)
- Rain Gear
- Additional pair of Socks
- Swimsuit, if appropriate
- Additional set of shoes/sneakers
- Sleeping Bag (rated to 40 °F for Spring and Fall) and Pillow (if needed)

#### **Toilet Articles**

- Toothpaste
- Toothbrush
- Handtowel
- Sunscreen
- Plastic Garbage bag to cover backpack if needed

### **Additional Items**

- Folding Camp Chair
- Cup, Plate or Bowl and Spork
- Water Bottle (1 Liter)
- Headlamp with Batteries
- Pocket Knife (no sheath knives)
- Spending Money for lunch on Sunday (\$10)
- Personal First Aid See 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Requirements for Contents
- Sunglasses
- Watch
- Camera and Film Optional

- MUST BE IN ORIGINAL LABELED PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE(S)
- Must be given to Scoutmaster in zip lock bag with written instructions/prior to leaving church parking lot.
